Our school was graded GOOD in all areas following our OfSTED inspection in November 2017 and the Governors wish to appoint a friendly, caring individual who can demonstrate excellent classroom practice and who can inspire both pupils and staff on our journey to become an outstanding school. They must have high expectations of pupil attainment, achievement and behaviour. We are looking for a commitment to develop the potential of children of all abilities, backgrounds and needs. Positivity, motivation, energy and a good sense of humour is essential! The successful candidate will receive a comprehensive induction plan and ongoing professional development throughout the year.

Christ Church & St Peter's is a large, two form entry, Church of England Primary School in the industrial village of Mountsorrel, situated on the A6 between Leicester and Loughborough. The village continues to grow with the development of new housing estates, and the school currently has 14 classes. Our children benefit from the excellent facilities at Soar Valley Leisure Centre and also enjoy regular visits to the local churches.

The school gained academy status in December 2014, as part of the Diocese of Leicester Academies Trust. We currently have 413 wonderful children on roll aged between 4 and 11 shared between 14 classes. In addition to our Head Teacher, we benefit from having a Deputy Head Teacher and an Assistant Head Teacher. All teachers except NQTs are responsible for an area of the curriculum.

We pride ourselves on being a happy, inclusive school, with a nurturing environment and a real sense of school community. The Inclusion Team is a strength of the school and they receive universal praise for the quality of their work from pupils, parents and OfSTED alike. The school will be opening an SEMH Resource Base later this year which will provide up to 10 places for pupils with Social, Emotional and Mental Health needs.
